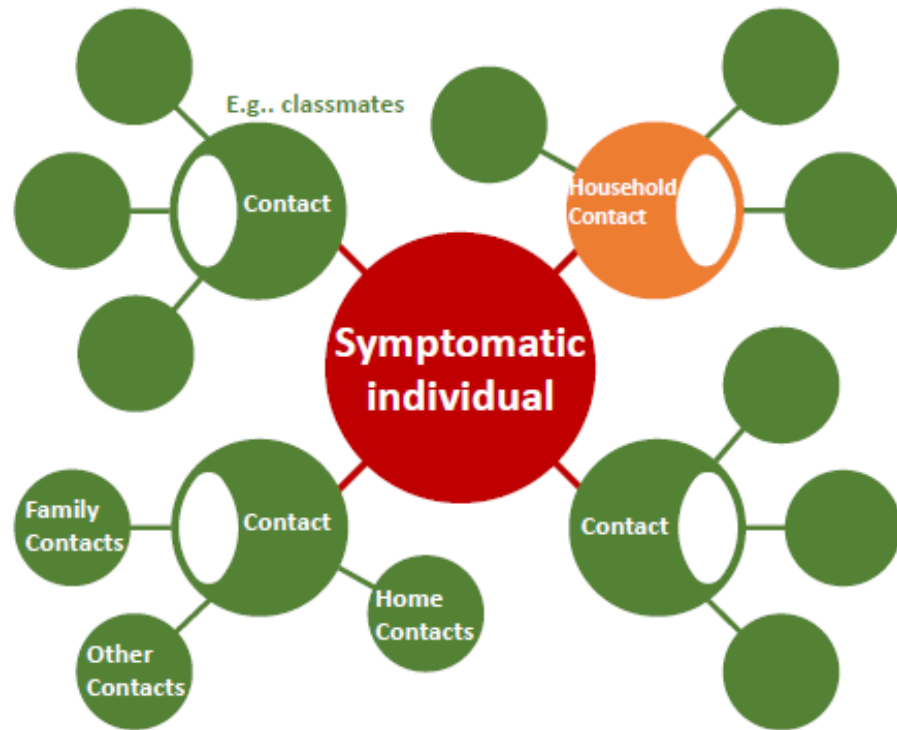


# Isolation

- Confirmed positive CASES need to isolate for 10 days – their household contacts need to isolate for 14 days regardless of symptoms or test outcome
- Confirmed positive CASES need to isolate for 10 days – their bubble contacts need to isolate for 14 days (from last contact) regardless of symptoms or their test outcome (***last contact on a Monday, isolation starts on Tuesday***)
- Confirmed positive CASES need to isolate for 10 days – household contacts of these bubble contacts do NOT need to isolate
- What counts as the bubble needing to isolate? This is being debated within PHE at the moment but currently whole bubble (where there is no social distancing – in class and/ or play time) would need to isolate
- Symptoms – they and their household need to isolate immediately; person with symptoms to book a test; if negative can return to normal as long as they are not contacts of a positive case and no fever for 48 hours
- **2 days** track back from test date or symptoms onset

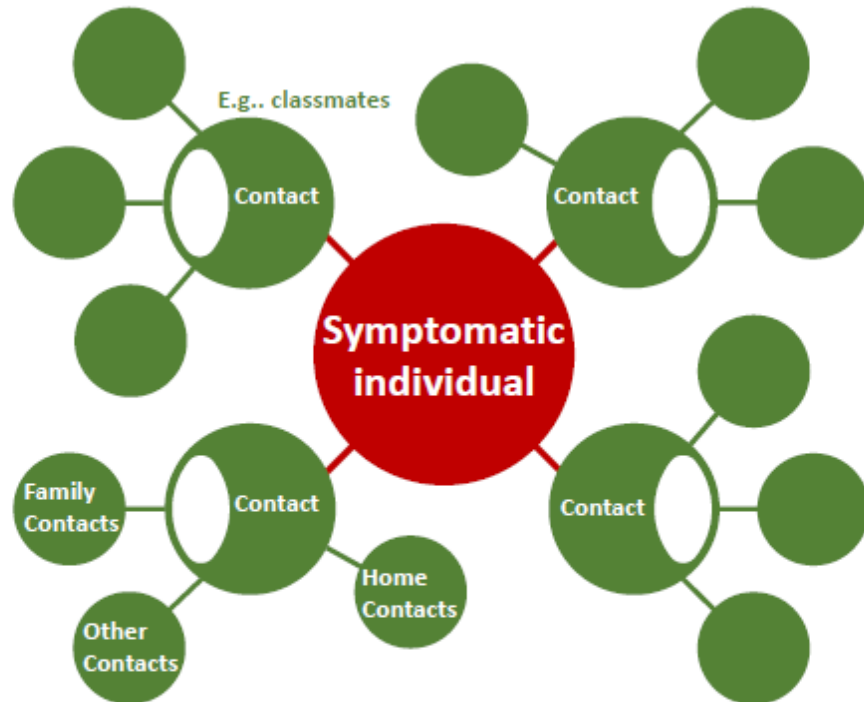

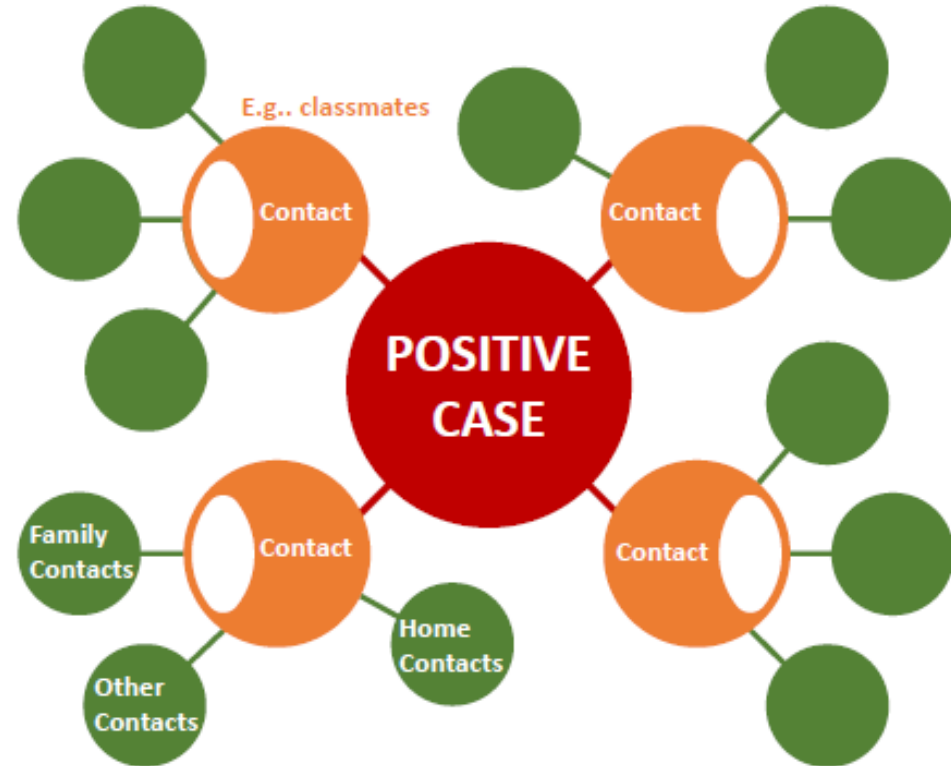
